eSentool 2.10.0

- Installed in January 2020
- New features:
 - Reorganization of the structure of the TED eSenders Workspace taking into account the most frequent asked questions (chapter “3. TED Schemas” contains all an eSenders need to know about the XML schemas)
- UI and REST WS alignment - *Get notice information*
- Review rules R007 (and R003) according to Dispatch Date



eSentool 2.10.1

- Installed in April 2020
- Features:
 - Update of the *Copyright Notice* section on the eSentool website *Legal notice* page

General conditions for the use of eSentool - key points 1 / 2

- TED eSenders must provide **one single access point for contact**
- TED eSender must be able to **cover the whole life-cycle of a notice under a certain directive** (incl. corrigendum)
- TED eSenders are **responsible for the content of the notices**
- The Publications Office can **refuse publication of a notice in case it does not comply with the validation rules or any other business rules**
- The Publications Office may **lock eSentool users' accounts**
- The Publications Office may **adapt at any moment the procedures for electronic reception of public procurement notices to comply with legal or technical requirements**





General conditions for the use of eSentool - key points 2/2

- The Publications Office may modify the publication schedule
- The Publications Office shares all relevant information with TED eSenders via TED eSentool and TED eSenders Workspace. Any communication to the eSenders will be addressed by the Publications Office via email
- TED eSenders are responsible for transmitting any relevant information coming from the Publications Office to their clients and vice-versa
- The communication between the Publications Office and TED eSenders shall take place in English, the contact address of the Publications Office is: OP TED Helpdesk: op-ted-helpdesk@publications.europa.eu.



eSentool 2.11.0

- Installed in November 2020
- Features:
 - A new business rule applying to F14 and checking the status of the referenced notice. If the status is *refused* or *not published* the rule fails and notice F14 is rejected
 - To have a link to a real notice in the publication number of simulation notices
