1. Available schemas

UBL & non-UBL document types

UBL conforming:

- Prior Information Notice
- Contract Notice
- Contract Award Notice

for Regulation annex forms, extended forms (E1 to E5), atypical forms (CEI, T01 & T02)

UBL Compatible:

- Society Registration Information Notice

for small forms (X01, X02)





2. Customization approach

Conformance over Compatibility

■ Compatibility:

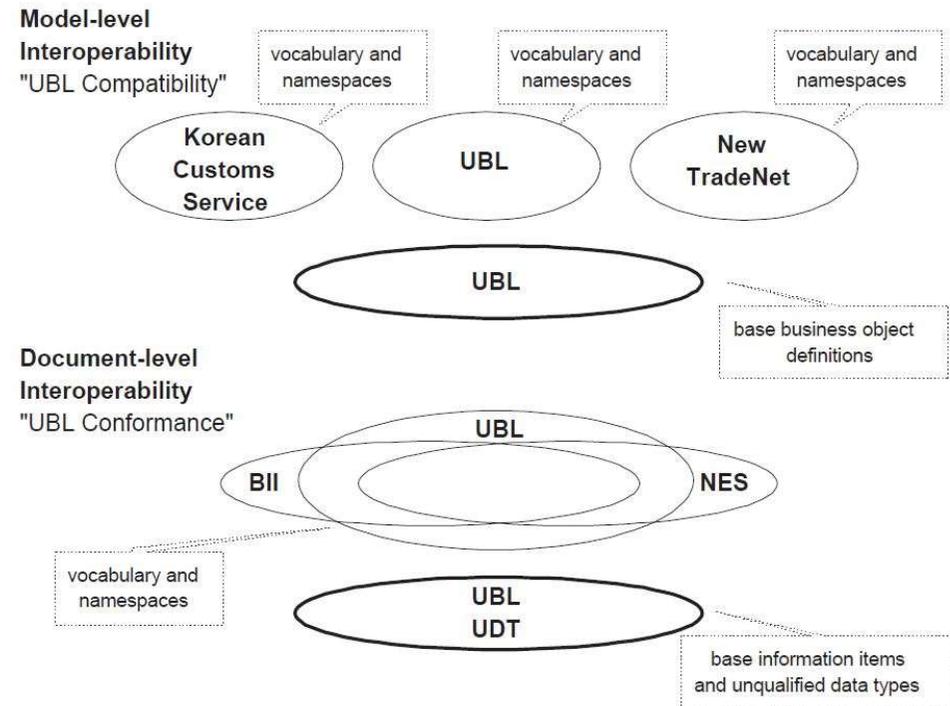
"new items & messages based on UBL library"

■ Conformance:

"ability to interchange UBL messages"
(shared vocabularies & namespaces)

■ As conformant as possible:

- Use existing elements in their context as much as possible
- Define as few extensions as possible



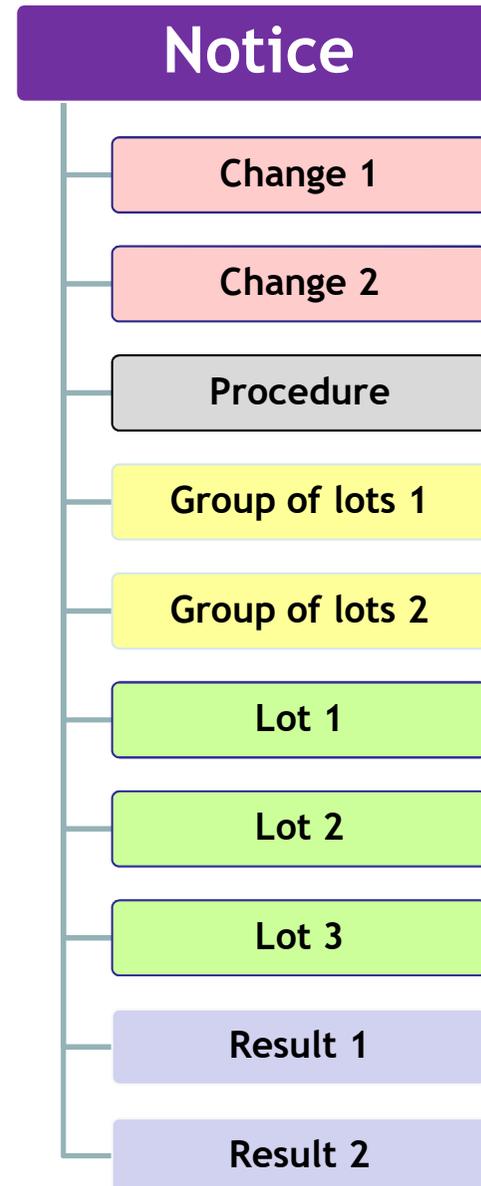

3. Information organization a) Change

Changed Notice

- Identification of the changed notice

■ At beginning of the notice,

Procurement Documents

- Changed & when.

■ What has changed, and

■ Why.

Changed Element

- What has changed (added, deleted, replaced)

■ On following slides:

listed elements are purely indicative. Their existence varies depending on notice type.

Change Reason

- Background reason.

Miscellaneous

- Dispatch Date; Publication preferred date; Legal Basis; Form & Notice Type; Notice languages; Buyers

■ Miscellaneous:

general notice/procedure information

Tendering Terms

- Cross Border Law; Other Legal Basis; Exclusion Grounds; Lots distribution

■ Tendering Terms:

General Terms & Conditions for the procedure

Tendering Process

- procedure features; procedure type; all lots; procedure accelerated

■ Tendering Process:

Process for the procedure

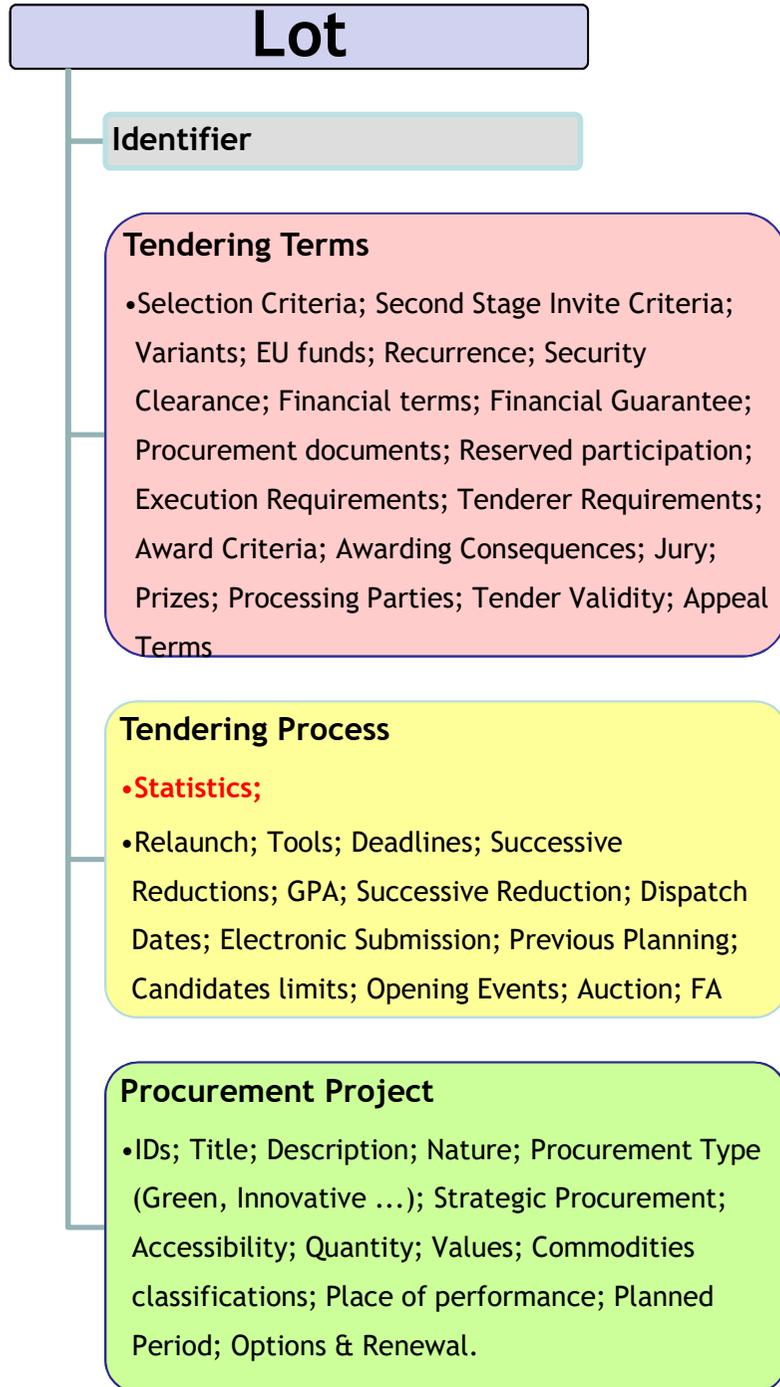
Procurement Project

- IDs; Title; Description; Nature; Notice values; Commodities classifications; Place of performance.

■ Procurement Project:

Description of the overall project covered by the procedure



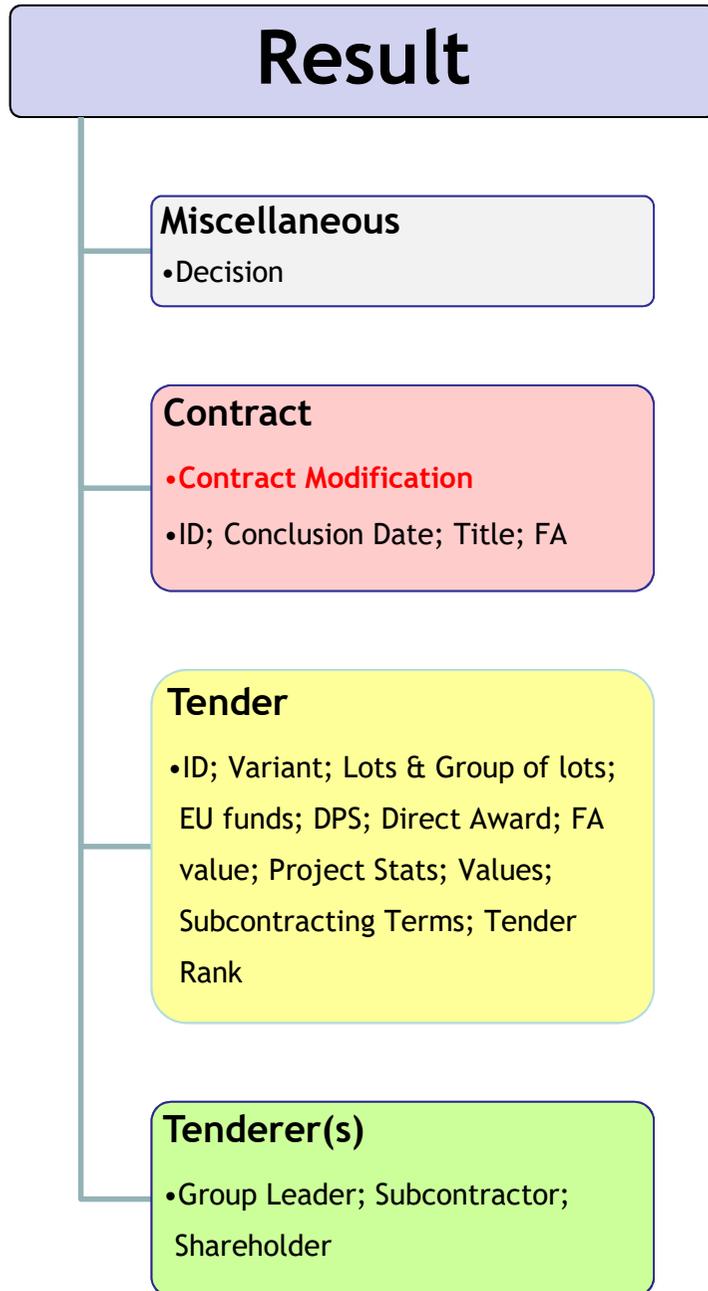

c) Part / Lot / Group of lots

- Indicative *(details will follow)*,
- Standards driven,
- Elements for the lot:
 - Tendering terms & conditions,
 - The process,
 - The scope.

- Made decision,
- Contract associated to the tender,
- Tender,
- Tenderer(s)

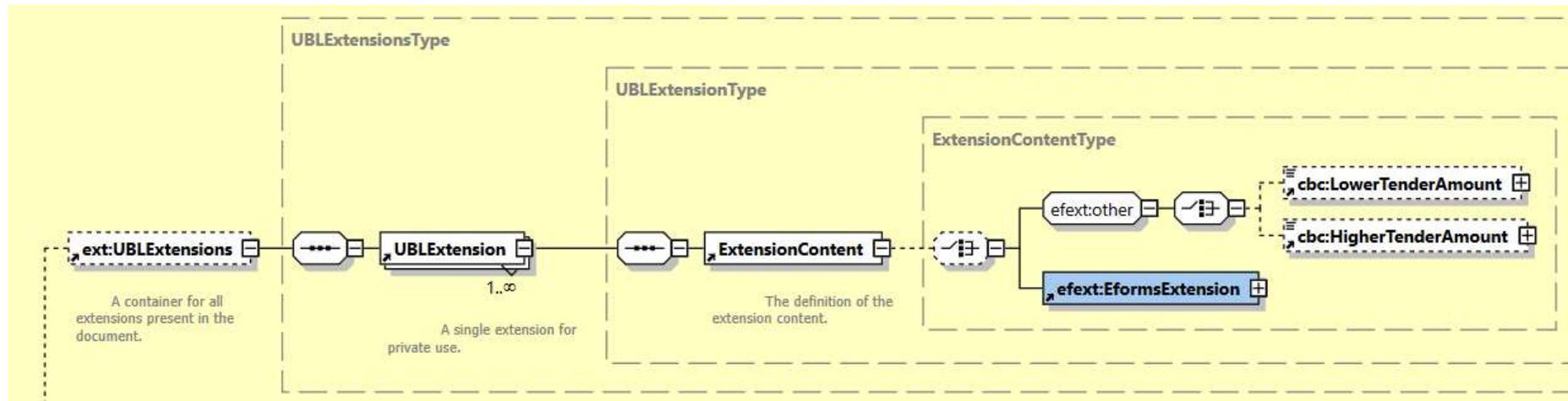

4. Extensions

a) Extensions definitions





4. Extensions

b) Definition for eForms

- Defined *when no suitable element available* in a given context
- Use of *elements from the common library* privileged
- Definition of *new aggregate elements with use of existing elements* from the library as much as possible
- *Reuse and* possible *evolutions* kept *in mind*

5. Gaps with the Regulation annex

Existing gaps in ...

a) Naming,

b) Data Type,

c) Fields:

- *Added*
- *Dropped*





5. Gaps with the Regulation annex

a) *Gaps in naming*

■ Requires a shift in mindset

■ Wording:

- **Organisation = Party** (e.g. consider the natural person John Doe, providing services),
- **Review = Appeal**
- **etc**

■ Multiple elements

with preferential order of use (Street => 1. StreetName, 2. AdditionalStreetName, 3. AddressLine)





5. Gaps with the Regulation annex

b) Gaps in DataType

■ Implicit requirements (e.g. *deadline: Date => Date + Time + TZ*)

■ Existing suitable elements having a different datatype
(*code vs Indicator*)

■ Trade-offs:

- Ability to cover the needs
- Opportunity for later evolution (e.g. Required level for Security Clearance could be later used instead of just Yes / No; a 3rd value “Not yet known” could easily be introduced without requiring a schema change; ...)
- Keep the highest possible UBL conformance rate

Identifier

Tendering Terms

- Selection Criteria; Second Stage Invite Criteria; Variants; EU funds; Recurrence; Security Clearance; Financial terms; Financial Guarantee; Procurement documents; Reserved participation; Execution Requirements; Tenderer Requirements; Award Criteria; Awarding Consequences; Jury; Prizes; Processing Parties; Tender Validity; Appeal Terms

Tendering Process

- **Statistics;**
- Relaunch; Tools; Deadlines; Successive Reductions; GPA; Successive Reduction; Dispatch Dates; Electronic Submission; Previous Planning; Candidates limits; Opening Events; Auction; FA

Procurement Project

- IDs; Title; Description; Nature; Procurement Type (Green, Innovative ...); Strategic Procurement; Accessibility; Quantity; Values; Commodities classifications; Place of performance; Planned Period; Options & Renewal.

5. Gaps with the Regulation annex c) Added / dropped fields

- Elements mandated by UBL (e.g. *cbc:ID* for *LegislationDocumentReference*, opportunity to introduce identifiers like ELI)
- Elements implicitly covered by the UBL construct (e.g. *XYZ Lot ID*)

6. Conclusion

- Schemas are standards based

- Standards have their own approach and extensions were necessary

- Products
 - 3 highly conformant schemas to cover 48 forms
 - 1 compatible schema for 2 forms
